

Naturerlebniscamp Birkengrund

Business Concept 2023 Open from Pentecost to October 2023

We operate a tent and caravan campsite on the edge of the Jasmund National Park on the island of Rügen. The site covers about 20,000m². It boasts a beautifully secluded location, where our only neighbours are the animals in the surrounding countryside and national park. Our proximity to nature has earned us a special place in the "Cool Camping" book as has the fact that we are not at all like other camping sites.

This is not the right address for those out to "impress" others with their binge drinking and ghetto blaster partying. At Birkengrund everyone has the right to do what he or she wants as long as their actions don't infringe on the rights and liberties of anyone else. Our guests love the peace and quiet of nature and come here to enjoy it.

Tent and Caravans:

We have two large grass meadow pitches. One is reserved for motorhomes and "tents with cars" next to the tent, and one for tents without cars. There are two other small camping areas under trees – an idyllic setting for tents without cars. Cars can be left in allocated spaces away from the camping area.

Hanomag Motorhome:

We do safaris with our ten Hanomag offroad vehicles, but for Hanomag freaks we still have three vintage Hanomag patrol vehicles converted into "rustic-style" motorhomes, each with a double bed. What you get: Just a bed, no ensuite bathroom or kitchen facilities, but you are protected from the elements. You will need to bring your own sleeping bag.

Location: Remote location right out in the countryside, close to the Jasmund National Park.

Bike Tours: A section of the Rügen roundtrip – Lancken train station to the Königsstuhl/National Park Jasmund – leads directly past our premises.

Train station: The distance to the camp site from Lancken train station is 1.5 km, and from Sassnitz 2.0 km

Shops: Lidl: 1.5 km, Aldi: 2.5 km, REWE: 2.0 km, Hagebau: 2.0 km, bike rentals: 5 km

Coffee service: We provide coffee and tea water (flat rate) free of charge in the morning.

Bread rolls: We provide fresh bread rolls free of charge in the morning. Please understand that this is a breakfast service and not intended to cater to sandwich needs during the day.

barbecue: barbecues with your own grill are allowed in front of your tent, if there is no risk of forest fire during your stay (due to very dry conditions).

Separate Toilet and Shower Facilities: Available for men and women. Each comprises: two toilets, four showers, three washbasins. No coins are needed; the showers are included in the price of the overnight stay.

Motorhomes and caravans: We only cater for small motorhomes such as minibuses, campers, vans, box vans, off-road vehicles or the like.

No larger motorhomes or caravans over 3.5 tons please. The space such vehicles requires makes them uneconomical for our small campground. They are not our target group: there is no satellite reception because the trees block reception, and we have no chemical toilet disposal point, just the normal toilet sewage system. The last 200m before the site is an old cobblestone road, which is in a bad state of repair, and unsuitable for larger camper vans with a long wheelbase. In urgent cases, provisional accommodation is possible, of course.

Cell Phone Charging: is possible free of charge in the coffee hut or at the reception.

Corona Hygiene Precautions: Please be responsible and maintain sufficient distance between the tents, and in the toilet and shower facilities. Disinfectant is available in each toilet. We have to record your contact information for tracking by the health department, should a case of Corona occur on our premises. Advance registration is desirable but not necessary. Please wear a face mask in areas where other people congregate.

Kitchen: There is an outdoor cooking and dishwashing area: gas stove, running water and sinks. Please be self-sufficient and bring everything with you. You cannot buy anything here except cold drinks (water, apple juice spritzer, beer, wine), intended for when you arrive without provisions. Catering and food sales is not part of our philosophy.

Booking: mandatory for Hanomag campers, desirable for tent and caravan owners, but not absolutely necessary. So far we have always had enough space for spontaneous arrivals.

Safaris: We offer daily safaris to places off the well-trodden tourist routes in our Hanomag offroad vehicles.

Prices 2022:

Our prices have been brought into line with other campsites and are based, logically enough, on the space you require. Our previous, simpler flat rate concept based on the number of people (heads) did not work, as it proved to be unfair for cyclists or hikers with only a small tent compared with, for example, caravans with an awning.

Prices (per night):

Coffee and tea water (all day, flat rate) and bread rolls (in the morning) free.
