**Operating concept 2025
open May 1st, 2025 to October 31st, 2025**

We operate a tent/campsite on the edge of the Jasmund National Park on the Jasmund peninsula on the island of Rügen. The site is around 20,000 square meters. Isolated location, no neighbors, just meadows and the beech forest of the national park with the chalk cliffs. We have been awarded in the book "cool camping" because of our proximity to nature and because we are completely different from normal campsites. The campsite has three rising terraces and a few idyllic niches.

Please note: Two large terraces are not available this year. Only a small terrace for tents and several niches. In 2025 we are limiting our offer to tents, small campers and vans the size of a VW bus. We no longer have space for mobile homes and caravans.

Our basic concept is to enable casual hiking camping for guests who want to travel around the island without any restrictions and spontaneously stay wherever they like. Island hopping without reservation and without registering a year in advance. The target group is therefore the classic "Van driver", motorcyclist, cyclist or hiker. We are more of a park4night campsite and if you like it, you can extend your stay daily. Therefore, families with children who stay in one place for weeks are conceptually rare with us and are not our concept either. Many guests stop off with us on their way to and from Sweden or Bornholm.

We are located on the edge of the Jasmund National Park directly on the "Rügenrundtour" cycle path in the middle of nature. Here you can go on wonderful hikes through the national park and along the chalk coast to the port of Sassnitz and back. A boat trip along the chalk coast rounds off the fantastic impressions. We give you a hiking map when you check in and recommend a three-hour circular hike that shows everything. The ten-kilometer-long beach from the Sassnitz ferry port via Prora to Binz is about six kilometers away.

We are still under construction, changing from a pioneering camp (children's holiday camp) to a campsite. The infrastructure with electricity on the pitches is only sufficient for lighting and refrigerators. Air conditioning, electric heaters and kettles are bursting the improvised supply lines. We provide coffee, hot water free of charge and rolls for a fee of €0.20 each as a service or to compensate for the restrictions.

There are functioning, free bathrooms with toilets, sinks and showers, which we try to keep clean several times a day. It would be nice if you left the bathrooms as you would like to find them.

If you want to attract unpleasant attention through noise, excessive loud drinking and partying with ghetto blasters, you are in the wrong place here. "One person's rights end where another's

rights are infringed." We love the peace and quiet of nature. We hope you do too. Then you have come to the right place.

Please understand that this campsite is not suitable for children for longer stays due to the many unlocked vintage cars, the lack of a playground and the long distance to the beach (approx. 5 km). Children and youth groups pay the adult price due to the increased general costs.

Dogs are allowed, but only on a leash so that other guests are not frightened and our free-roaming boss is not caught.

Our main business is safaris with vintage cars. That is why you have to lovingly accept the sight of a fleet of Hanomag group vehicles from the sixties and various spare parts donors.

If you don't like what is described now, please stay away. Then bad and unjustified reviews in the modern internet pillory are also unnecessary.

Tents/Camping:

This year, 2025, we only have a smaller camping area for campers without a "car at the tent". The car can be parked within sight. There are several niches available for small motorhomes and "tents with cars". There are also two other small camping areas under trees for tents in an idyllic natural setting without cars.
